From september 10 to 29, the exhibition "Underneath the surface" (German: "Unter der Oberfläche"), will provide information about the aquatic life in East Germany's bodies of water. The show will also provide information about the ecological quality of certain bodies of water. It will start at Potsdam Central Station close to Berlin and will travel through several German cities.
